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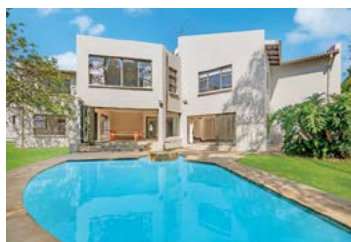

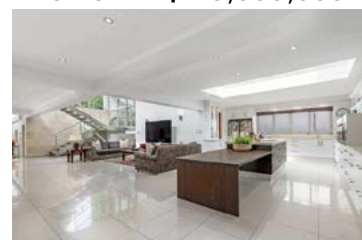

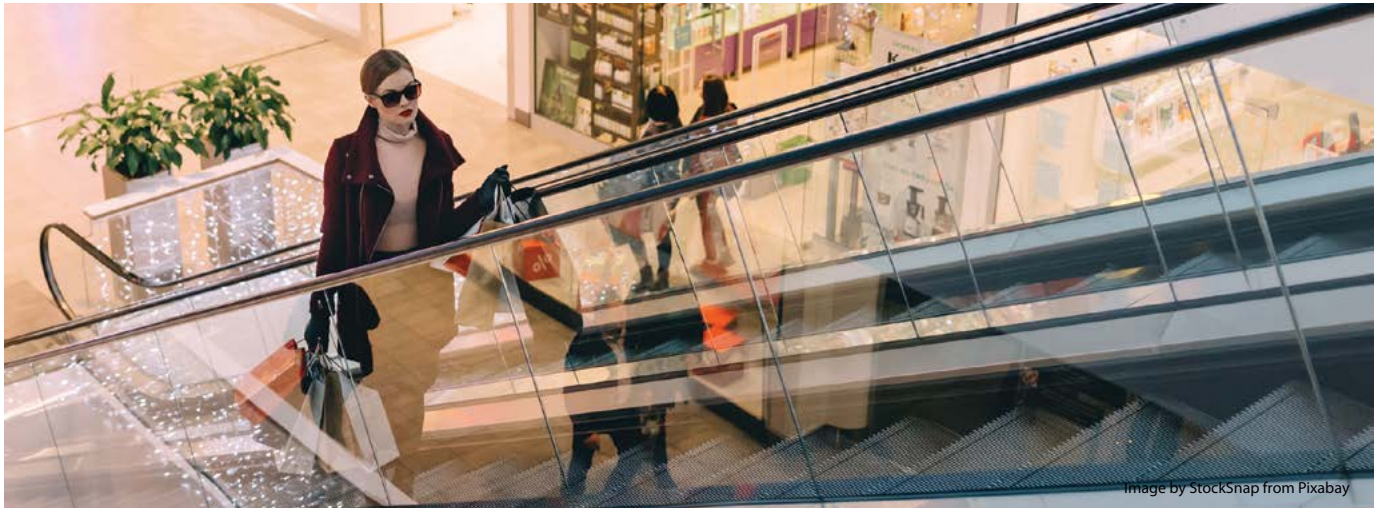
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Black Friday, Cyber Monday, and the festive shopping rush should be times of excitement, not anxiety. You've worked hard for your money – don't let criminals or carelessness rob you of your joy this shopping season.

24/7 Security Services urges everyone to keep safety and security top of mind. Staying alert and informed will help ensure your shopping experience is both happy and safe.

Safety at the Mall

South African shopping centres are at their busiest during November and December, making it easy for opportunistic criminals to blend into the crowd. A few smart habits can make all the difference.

- **Park wisely** – Choose well-lit parking areas close to entrances or under CCTV surveillance.

- **Shop on secure sites** – Look for a padlock icon in the browser bar and ensure the web address begins with 'https://'. Use only trusted payment platforms.
- **Stick to reputable retailers** – Only buy from recognised websites. Be cautious of unfamiliar sites offering unusually low discounts.
- **Avoid public Wi-Fi** – Never shop or bank online using open networks in malls or coffee shops; these are easy targets for hackers.
- **Be cautious of phishing scams** – Fraudsters often send fake emails or messages that appear legitimate. Avoid clicking on suspicious links.
- **Use strong passwords** – Combine uppercase letters, symbols, and numbers to create a secure password of at least eight characters.
- **Activate two-factor authentication** – OTPs (one-time PINs) and authentication apps provide essential extra protection for your accounts.
- **Monitor your transactions** – Check your bank statements regularly and report any suspicious activity immediately.

Know how to use the emergency button

Most apps include an in-app emergency feature that connects you directly to local police or private security partners. Take a moment to locate and understand how it works before your next trip.

Rate and report every trip

Your feedback helps keep everyone safe. Always rate your driver and share comments after your trip – whether positive or negative. Reporting unsafe or suspicious behaviour helps e-hailing companies maintain strong safety standards and take swift action where needed.

Stay connected

Keep your phone fully charged before booking a ride and ensure your mobile data is active. This allows you to stay in touch with your driver, share trip details, and access safety features. With load-shedding and long commutes, carrying a power bank is a smart move too.

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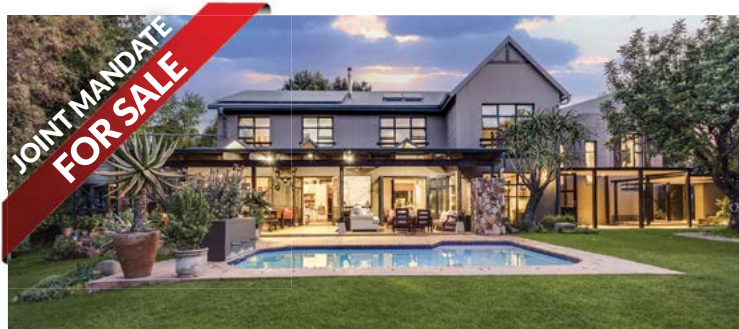

Picture this scenario: When you get to your destination, all you want to do after a long, tiring drive is to unpack, unwind and relax. This way, if you feel the accommodation is unsuitable, you can leave and go to another place. Research to see if they have any weight or breed restrictions, what the maximum number of pets allowed per room is, whether there are time limits as to how long a pet can be left alone or whether you need to provide up-to-date vaccination records.

It is also good to see what their amenities offer. Are there pet relief areas, dog parks and play areas? Do they provide any pet essentials in the room, like bedding, bowls or treats? If they do, then that saves space in the car. Are there pet-friendly beaches and restaurants in the area? Do they offer a pet-sitting service if you go out? Are there any areas where my pet is not allowed (dining room or pool areas)? Are there noise level rules so that you don't have to put up with non-stop barking?

Going on holiday with your pet can be so much fun. But it can also be stressful if you haven't done your research!
