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WHAT QUESTION WOULD YOU ASK YOUR PET?

If you could, by some magic wand, ask your pet one question – and the animal gave you a meaningful answer – what would it be?

Karolina Westlund (PhD) is an Associate Professor of Ethology in Sweden. She has a large international database of students, and a few years ago she posed this very question to all her subscribers. She received roughly 250 responses, and here's how they broke down:

- 48% wanted to be of service to their animals, asking questions such as: "How can I make your life better?" or "How can I make you happier?"
- 25% wanted to inquire about their pets' emotional states: "Are you happy?" "What makes you happy?" "Why are you so fearful?"
- 7% asked about pain: "Are you in pain?" or "Where does it hurt?"
- 7% posed more philosophical questions, such as: "What is it like to be a horse?"
- 5% had practical questions, including: "How can I teach you to come when called?"
- 3% tried to "hack the code" to continue the conversation: "Teach me to understand your language..." or "Show me what 'yes' and 'no' look like..."
- The remaining 6% asked a variety of other questions, such as: "Why do you prefer my husband even though I'm the one who feeds you and takes care of you?" or "Why do you insist on spending all morning outside, then coming inside and producing a poop while I'm in the shower?"



She went on to analyse the data further, looking at the types of words used in the questions, and found the following:

- Overall, 46% of people asked questions that included an emotional word somewhere in their question, such as happy, fearful, calm, safe, or loved.
- A striking 23% of all questions included the word "happy".

As Karolina points out, this suggests that an animal's emotional state is deeply important to animal lovers – or at least to the 250 people who participated in her poll. More specifically

So, as she says, it seems that an animal's emotional state is very important to animal lovers, or at least the 250 people who participated in her poll. More specifically, it highlights just how central an animal's happiness is to the way we think about and relate to our pets.

As an Animal Behaviourist, it is heartwarming to hear these responses. I mulled over what question I would ask my animals. After much thought, my question would be: "If you had it all over again, would you still choose me to be your owner?"

What would be your question?

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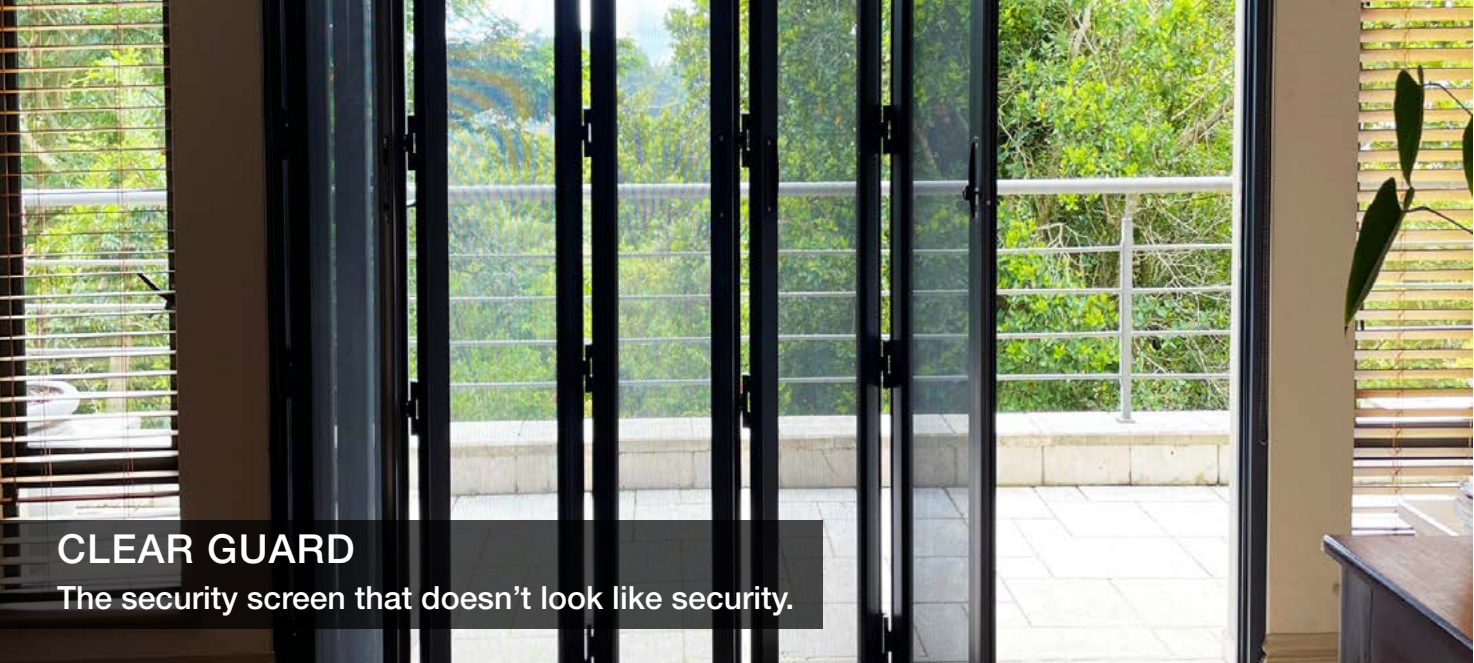


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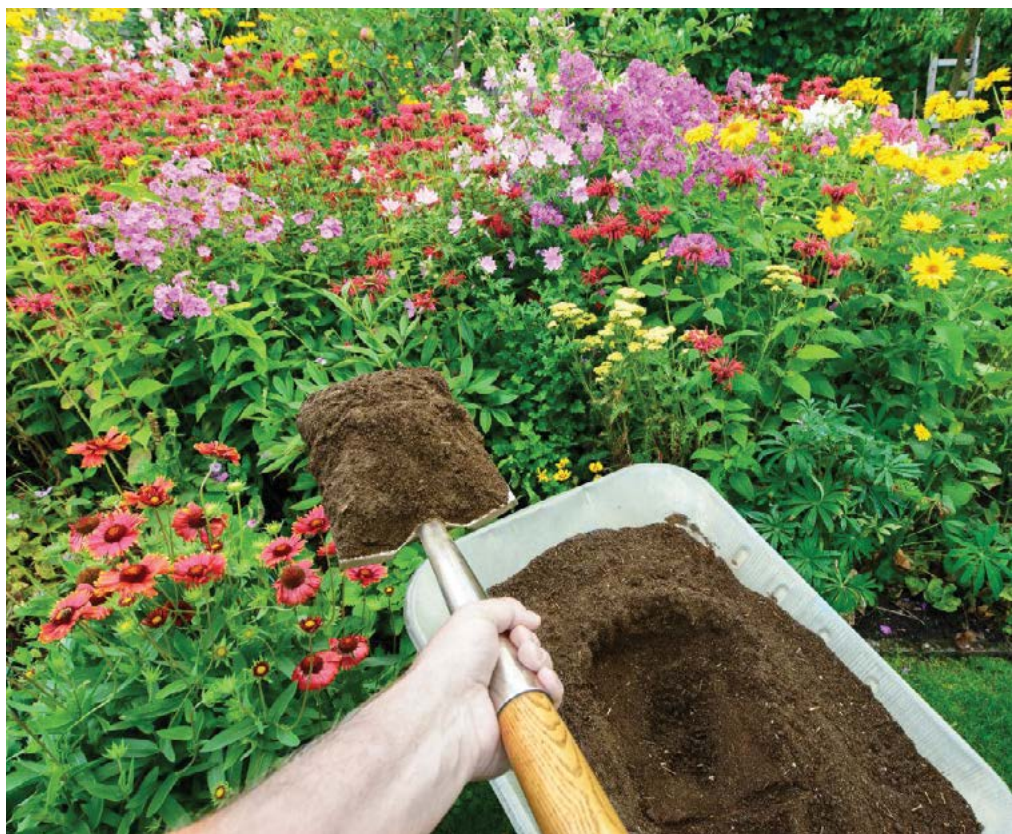
HEALTHY PLANTS START WITH HEALTHY SOIL: WHAT EVERY RESIDENT SHOULD KNOW

If you've ever wondered why some gardens flourish while others seem to struggle no matter how often they are watered or fertilised, the secret usually lies below the surface, in the soil. Long before you plant a tree, sow a lawn, or fill a flower bed, the condition of the soil determines how well your plants will grow. Understanding what your soil is made of, what it needs, and which plants it naturally supports is one of the easiest ways to achieve a beautiful, low-maintenance garden.

Soil is far more than just "dirt." It's a living layer made up of minerals, organic matter, water and air. The balance between these elements is what gives soil its texture and structure. Most soils consist of three types of mineral particles: sand, silt and clay. Sandy soils feel gritty and drain quickly, which means they often dry out and lose nutrients faster. Clay soils are dense and sticky when wet, but they hold nutrients well even though they can become compacted. Somewhere in between is silt, which creates fertile but sometimes waterlogged conditions. When these three components mix evenly, they form loam, a balanced, soft, crumbly soil that drains well yet still holds moisture. Loam is considered the ideal soil for most gardens.

Knowing what kind of soil you have helps you choose plants that will naturally thrive. For example, sandy soils are perfect for fynbos, aloes, succulents and Mediterranean herbs like lavender and rosemary. Clay soils support roses, fruit trees and many indigenous shrubs that enjoy moisture and mineral-rich ground. Loam is suitable for almost anything, including lawns, vegetables and mixed beds. Rather than fighting against your soil by constantly amending it, choosing plants that are naturally suited to it will save time, money and effort.

Healthy soil also depends on the nutrients and organic matter it contains. Plants rely on three major nutrients, nitrogen for leafy growth, phosphorus for strong roots and flowering, and potassium for overall resilience. Compost and other organic materials increase the soil's carbon content,



improving water retention, drainage, and the activity of beneficial organisms such as earthworms and microbes. Soil pH also matters: acidic soils favour plants like azaleas and blueberries, neutral soils suit lawns and vegetables, and alkaline conditions are ideal for shrubs like lavender and rosemary. Simple home test kits make it easy to check your soil's pH.

Different parts of a garden need different approaches to soil care. Lawns benefit from annual aeration to relieve compaction, followed by a light layer of compost and occasional nitrogen-rich fertiliser. Deep but infrequent watering encourages strong root systems. Flower beds thrive when compost is added twice a year and a layer of mulch is used to retain moisture and suppress weeds. Planter boxes require more regular attention because their soil becomes depleted faster; using a good quality potting mix, refreshing part of the soil annually and ensuring proper drainage will keep container plants healthy. Larger grassland or open areas benefit from minimal disturbance, gentle mowing or grazing pressure, and the encouragement

of indigenous grasses suited to the local soil.

Focusing on soil health has benefits far beyond individual gardens. It reduces water use, lowers landscape maintenance costs, increases plant survival, supports biodiversity and improves the overall appearance of communal spaces. Healthy soils absorb rainfall more effectively, reduce erosion and create a stronger, more resilient landscape.

The simple truth is that healthy plants begin with healthy soil. By understanding the ground beneath our feet and caring for it appropriately, residents can enjoy gardens and shared green spaces that look better, last longer and require far less intervention.

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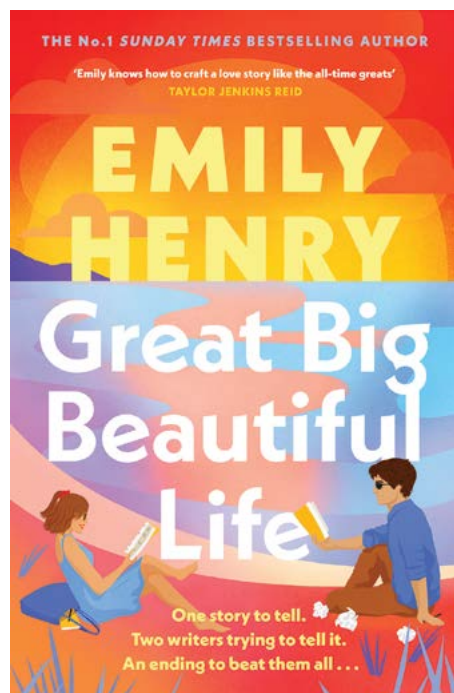

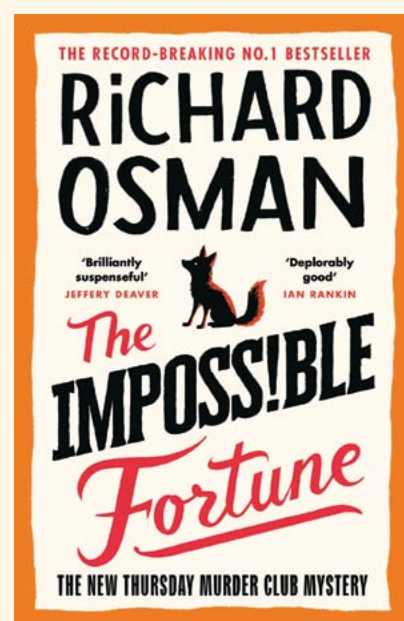

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NAMIBIA, WHERE TIME HOLDS ITS BREATH

There are few places left in the world where silence feels sacred. Namibia is one of them. It begins with the light, its honeyed glow turning rock into gold and shadow into story. Out there, distances deceive you. Dunes appear close enough to touch, then shift with every breath of wind. The horizon moves, the earth breathes, and for a while you forget you're standing on the same planet that plays host to rush hour.

The desert that dreams

The Namib desert is often mistaken for the Sahara in photographs. It's a confusion that flatters both. The Namib is older, perhaps the oldest desert on earth, its rust-coloured dunes shaped by wind and time into something almost sculptural. The locals call it "the vast place", and it is. But vast doesn't mean empty. If you stand quietly, you'll hear the sand move – it emits a low, humming sigh as the wind reshapes the landscape grain by grain.

At dawn, the light catches the dunes like molten copper; at dusk, the dunes cool into a velvet shadow. I stood once at the edge of Sossusvlei as the sun dipped below the horizon and the silence pressed in – a deep and physical silence, the kind that fills you rather than frightens you.

Drive through Namib-Naukluft National Park and you begin to understand why this country's citizens can't be rushed. The road stretches forward like a suggestion, bordered by nothing and everything – thornbush, salt pans, mirages. The air smells of dust and distance. Ostriches cross as if late for something, springboks appear and vanish... the whole landscape feels half-dreamed, half-remembered.

Where water cuts through stone

Far south, the Fish River Canyon opens suddenly, a quiet thunder in the land. It's one of the largest canyons in the world, but there's nothing grandiose about it. The silence is steady, the scale not flashy.

Standing on the rim, you sense how ancient this earth is and how little it asks of you beyond respect.

The air is dry enough to taste. The wind has its own rhythm. Somewhere below, a single river thread twists between shadows. Photographs don't capture it; they only flatten what is, in truth, a living thing.

Land of tribes and memory

Head north, and Namibia changes tone. The ochre plains give way to scrub and smoke, and the light sharpens again. This is Kaokoland, home to the proud Himba people, who still live much as their ancestors did – herding cattle, tending fires and covering their skin with a deep red mixture of ochre and butter fat.

Visiting a Himba village feels less like looking back in time and more like standing still in it. There's rhythm in their way of life, a kind of quiet choreography: women grinding

ochre, children laughing somewhere unseen, the faint smell of woodsmoke and wild herbs curling through the air.

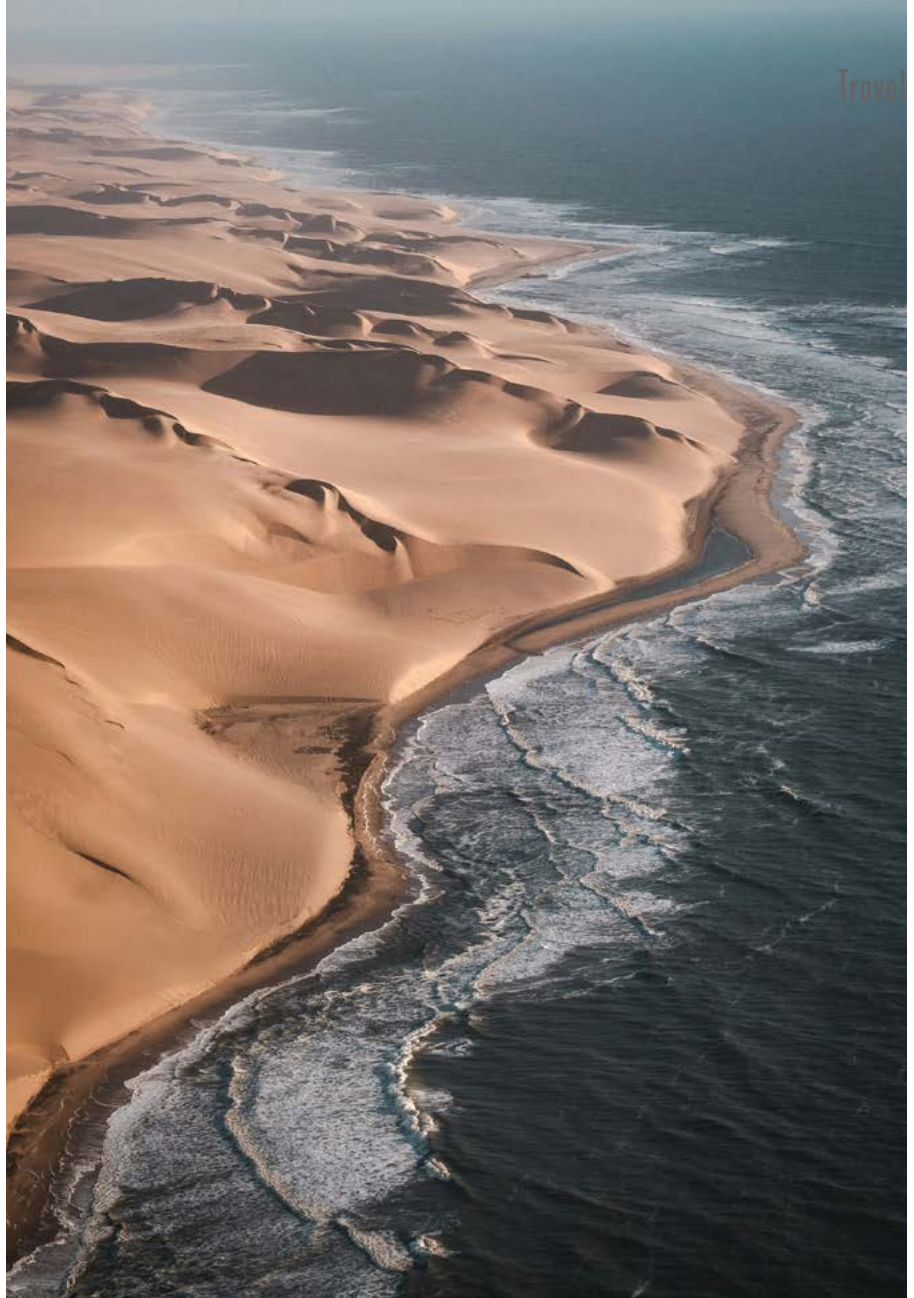
Further east, in Damaraland, the ground itself tells stories. The rock engravings at Twyfelfontein – of giraffes, hunters and spirals – have watched over this valley for thousands of years. They speak of survival, celebration and faith carved into stone by the San long before the idea of Namibia existed.

Nearby, at the Damara Living Museum, that heritage is actively practised as women describe the bush plants from which food, medicine and perfume are derived. Men demonstrate fire-lighting, carving and the art of patient creation. It isn't performance, it's preservation; a small yet steady act of keeping identity alive.

Rivers, waterfalls and hidden villages

Follow the sound of water and you'll find Epupa Falls, where the Kunene River tumbles over a series of rocky ledges near the Angolan border. "Epupa" means foam, and it's apt – the spray rises like breath against the sky. Children play along the banks, the Himba women weave beads in the shade, and the whole place hums with a kind of gentle continuity.

Further east, the Mbunza Living Museum near Rundu sits beside a quiet lake. Here,



the Kavango people share their traditional crafts and stories. There's laughter, leather and the smell of Mangetti nut oil on the breeze. It's a small place, but deeply moving – proof that culture, like the river itself, keeps finding a way to flow.

The kingdom of dust and light

We reach vast, white and shimmering Etosha. The great pan stretches endlessly, alive with mirages and movement. When rain comes, it becomes a mirror. Elephants move like slow grey tides, zebras stripe the horizon and flamingos rise in pale clouds.

There's something transcendent about watching wildlife in such a stark place; it's as if the animals themselves have learned to become part of the light. You realise, after a while, that Namibia's beauty isn't only visual, it's structural. It sits in the bones of the land, and if you're still and quiet enough, you can feel it hum beneath your feet.

A journey measured in stillness

Namibia isn't a country you visit; it's a country you listen to.

It teaches patience as you wait for colour to shift, for the wind to change, for silence to speak. You arrive thinking you're chasing beauty, but you leave knowing you've been taught reverence.

As my plane lifted off from Windhoek, the landscape unrolled below me – red dunes, pale salt, green veins of river – and I realised I wasn't leaving anything behind. I was simply taking a quieter version of myself home.
